

Lesson 7 Eighth Notes and Rests

Single eighth note with a flag


When you have two or more eighth notes, they may be joined together with a beam across the top.

①



In this two-part counting system you will count the first beat as 1 and the second beat as “+” (and). Continue this counting system through the bar, including rests. Play quarter note time on the bass drum.

②



③ Tap foot on 1-2-3-4 counting, 1 an 2 an 3 an 4 an.

④ Hear 8th notes as you play.


